### DESCRIPTION

Methylene chloride, can be distilled

## **ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS**

### **Parameters:**

- pH: between 4 and 9
- Water < 5%
- Sediment < 1%
- Flashpoint > 55°C

#### **General conditions:**

- · Must not be mixed with other hazardous substances or other chlorinated solvents
- No toxic or carcinogenic substances
- No PCBs
- No polymerising, oxidising or reactive substances.
- No foreign objects (such as wood, stone, glass, rags, plastic lids or metal parts).
- No finely divided light metals like aluminium or zinc

#### Packaging conditions:

- Methylene chloride must be packed in UN approved liquid drums
- IBCs are not permitted for pure methylene chloride because of high vapour pressure
- The drum must be in good condition and be leakproof
