# Herbicides and pesticides, liquid

<b>Waste code</b>	<b>017025</b>

### DESCRIPTION

Expired liquid herbicides and pesticides, packaged in their original commercial packaging and max. 50 kg per drum.

### ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

#### General conditions:

- No radioactive waste;
- No explosives.
- No herbicides or pesticides with aluminium phosphide or magnesium phosphide base (at risk of forming toxic phosphinic gas).
- No pressurised containers (such as spray cans).
- No freons.
- No batteries.
- No products with a flashpoint < 100°C.

#### Packaging conditions:

- The waste must be packed in tightly closed bottles (inner packaging) of a maximum capacity of 5 litres. Those bottles must in turn be packed in durable UN approved open head drums (outer packaging) of max. 120 litres, filled with absorbent material. The bottles must be firmly secured with the closure at the top using suitable filling materials so that the bottles cannot break under normal transport conditions.
- The packaging, including the pallets on which the waste is stacked, will be regarded as lost packaging.
