

## CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE

# Tar-free asphalt rubble

### DESCRIPTION

Asphalt that from (repair) work on roads and road substrates.

Asphalt is considered tar-free if the concentration of PAH10 is equal to or lower than 75 mg/kg.

The waste producer must submit a report conform CROW210 to prove that the asphalt rubble is tar-free.

### Permitted

- Asphalt rubble
- Milled asphalt

Maximum size is 60 x 60 cm

### Prohibited

- Hazardous waste
- Construction and demolition waste
- Commercial waste
- Tar-containing asphalt rubble
- Road marking
- Sand/soil >5 v%
- Contaminated sand/soil
- Asbestos or suspect asbestos-containing materials
- Rubble from chimneys
- Asphalt, rubble and concrete waste originating from suspect contaminated locations, such as petrol stations, car dismantling sites, remediation sites
